In order to help every child “be the best they can be”, it’s important that the school, parents/carers and students understand their responsibilities and work together. To achieve this:

We expect the school to:

- Provide a safe, happy and stimulating environment in which students are encouraged to reach their full potential and to respect each other, people and property
- Teach effectively a broad and balanced curriculum, which takes account of the needs of each child
- Care for each child as an individual
- Share information with parents/carers on their child’s progress and achievements
- Welcome opportunities to receive information from parents/carers, as appropriate, including informal meetings, telephone contacts and visits
- Set homework that helps extend independent learning, is suitable for the child and does not take disproportionate amounts of time

We expect parents/carers to:

- Take an active interest in the progress of their child
- Support the authority and discipline of the school
- Ensure that their child attends school regularly and on time, appropriately dressed and with the correct equipment. Please note: Students are discouraged to bring mobile phones/personal devices into school. If they do, it will be at their own risk and they are required to hand them in at the school office on arrival in the morning and to collect them when they leave at the end of the day.
- Notify the school if their child is absent from school by 9.00am that day
- Encourage their child to complete their homework on time and to the best of their ability
- Attend parents evenings and school events

We expect pupils to:

- Come to school regularly and on time
- Leave their mobile phone and personal device at home. If they do bring it in, it will be at their own risk and they must hand them in to the school office in the morning and collect them at the end of the day
- Dress appropriately and come to lessons with the correct equipment for learning
- Be helpful, friendly, kind and considerate to other people and follow the school behaviour policy
- Do their best at all times
- Care for books, equipment, furniture and property, as well as the buildings, grounds and surroundings of the school
- Try to complete their homework on time and to the best of their ability
- Follow school rules
- Take home all school letters
- Represent Belmont to the best of their ability in school and on the way to and from school
