## General welcome.

Reps were welcomed back and discuss that they would be in post until the end of term one, to allow elections to take place.

## New Structure.

The new structure of the school council will be as follows:

- Old Reps will stay in post until the end of term 1, to allow elections to take place.
- Students wishing to become class reps will talk to their class explaining what they will offer. Voting will be held on the same day with voting slips.
- Three students from the class reps will be voted in as KS reps, to form a small group to be able to carry out special duties on behalf of the council and school. Reps wishing to be KS reps will be asked to create a single Power Point slide about why they should have this role.
- One student from KS4 voted to be School Council President, they will chair the meetings with Mr Fry and report directly to Mr Day on a termly basis. KS4 Reps wishing to apply for this will be asked to make a short video clip of themselves, explaining why they would make a good School Council President.

Class rep voting will take place in tutor groups.

KS reps and School Council President voting will be done as a whole school. It will be supported by an assembly, where the slides and video clips will be shown. All pupils will then vote for their KS rep and School Council President.

We will have a proper voting booth and students will go and vote in their tutor groups.

## F@B Donation

Reps have suggested that some of it be used to purchase 'Wet Play' games such as Uno, playing cards, colouring sheets etc. These are to be kept in boxes in classes that are used. Also a shelter was asked for.
