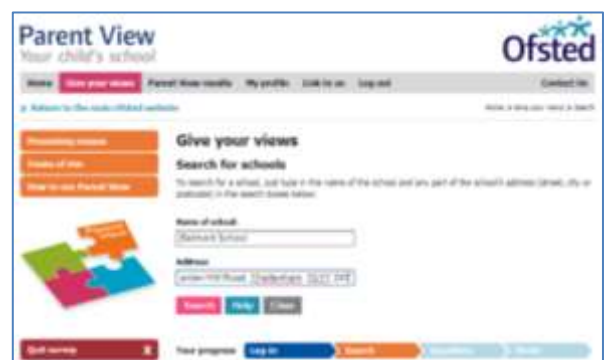
1. Go to the Parent View website via Google or type: <https://parentview.ofsted.gov.uk/>
2. Click on 'Give **your** views now'.
3. If this is the first time you've used Parent View click on 'Register now' or login.
4. To register: enter email address, answer questions, tick box and click on 'Register now'. This will send an email to you with a link to a 'one time' log in page.
5. After accessing your email and clicking on the link - on the next screen click on 'Log In'.

6. This screen allows you to set your password and save. You can now log in as normal.

7. Enter name and address of school:

8. Confirm the school on the next screen.



9. Answer the preliminary questions and click on continue to take you into the Ofsted questionnaire.
